Re: Discharge by 11 Project Metrics


Performance against the Discharge by 11am target of 75% has remained relatively static over this period with the year to date result sitting at 29.3% (an increase of 1% on the YTD result for October 2011).

There has over recent times been a change in the reasons for delay. Whilst results for 'waiting for transport' remains variable, it is pleasing to note that the number of patients 'waiting for discharge paper work' has diminished and reflects the effort that has gone into streamlining this process. The main reason cited causing delay is currently 'clinical decision'. In some cases this relates to the patients needing to meet specific criteria prior to being considered safe for discharge.

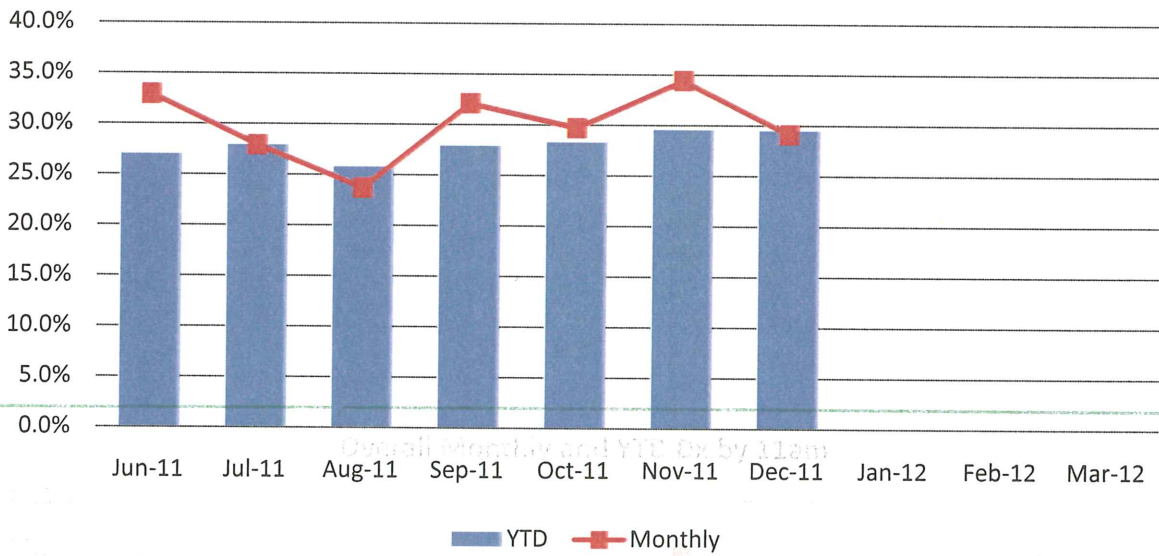
