

HWNZ Clinical Mentoring Support Plan

HWNZ funding supports workforce development through academic and clinical learning in the area of advanced clinical nursing. Clinical mentoring supports nurses to extend knowledge and skills through clinical experience, critical thinking, skilled health assessment and comprehension of diagnostic measures and outcomes. These skills are required for evidence based clinical reasoning.

Clinical Mentoring is the provision of teaching, coaching and mentoring by a relevant registered health professional (experienced competent practitioner) to support the HWNZ trainee to integrate their postgraduate learning into the practice setting.
