How Group 4 will book on Book My Vaccine – step by step

You will receive an invitation via email or text message when you become eligible to book your vaccination.

In some situations where people don't have a mobile phone or email address, they may be contacted by phone or letter. Kia ora [first name]

You can book your free COVID-19 vaccination appointments now.

You'll need to book 2 appointments and it's very important you get both doses of the vaccine – this will give you the best protection.

You can also make vaccination bookings for anyone aged 16 and over in your whānau by calling the COVID Vaccination Healthline on **0800 28 29 26**.

How to book your free COVID-19 vaccination appointments

To book your vaccination, go to BookMyVaccine.nz

When you book, you will need to provide your name, date of birth and contact information. You can view our privacy policy at: BookMyVaccine.nz/privacy

You can ask your whānau or a friend to help you book your appointment if you need assistance.

If you want more information about vaccination or if you're not able to book online, you can call the COVID Vaccination Healthline on **0800 28 29 26**.

All calls are free and the team are available from 8am to 8pm, 7 days a week. You can ask for an interpreter if you need one.

You may receive a letter or an SMS from us with information about how to book. If you've already made your vaccination bookings, or you've already had your vaccinations, you don't need to do anything else and can ignore this email.


The next step is confirmation of eligibility. If the person is eligible, they can continue to book now. If they're in a group not currently being vaccinated, they can leave their details and will be invited back to pick booking times when they are eligible (screenshots of this process later in this document).



People are then asked if they're 60 or over.

If you're under the age of 60 – you have an opportunity to state if you're in group 1, 2, or 3. This is because people who aren't in the eligible group 4 age bands still need to be able to book if they're in groups 1, 2, or 3. For example, recently pregnant people or those diagnosed with cancer.

Are you in Groups 1, 2, or 3?

Group 1 – Border and managed isolation and quarantine (MIQ) workers and the people they live with.

Group 2 – High-risk frontline workers and people living in high-risk places. This includes, but is not limited to:

- people living and working in long-term residential environments (not including halls of residence or boarding schools)
- people who care for older Māori and Pacific people.

Group 3 – People who are at risk of getting very sick from COVID-19. This includes, but is not limited to:

- people eligible for a publicly funded influenza vaccine
- pregnant people
- disabled people and their carers
- people diagnosed with severe mental illness
- people who are severely obese (defined as a BMI ≥40)
- people with high blood pressure requiring 2 or more medications for control

If you're eligible – you can then say if you've already had one dose. The booking tool will calculate when you're eligible for your next vaccine based on the date you input. For Pfizer, the system will calculate 21 days, for all other vaccines (not including Janssen which is one dose) the system will calculate 28 days.
